2 PAY AGREEMENT 1996

Revised Rates of Pay Effective from 7th November, 1996

AS in previous years, the method of calculating Firefighters average earnings in respect of the Pay Formula was by a sample of earnings of qualified firefighters.

This was carried out by the Lower Ranks Committee and used to calculate the 1996 Pay Settlement. This produced a figure of 4.4 per cent which was applied to all sections.

SALARIES OF CHIEF AND ASSISTANT CHIEF FIRE OFFICERS

- We are writing to inform you that the NJC has agreed a general salary increase of 2.9% with effect from 1st July 1996. All existing salaries and salary scales for officers within the scope of the NJC are to be increased by these amounts rounded to the nearest £3. Revised salary ranges are attached.
- 2. Assistant Chief Fire Officers/Firemasters, except those appointed as Deputy Chief Fire Officers, shall have their salary scale adjusted so that on 1st July 1996 it is at 75% at all points of the scale of the Chief Fire Officer as determined in accordance with paragraph 5.2(1) to 5.2(3) of the Gold Book. Those appointed as Deputies shall likewise have their scale adjusted so that it is at 80% at all points of the scale of the Chief Fire Officer as determined in accordance with paragraph 5.1(1) to 5.2(3) of the Gold Book.
- New "underpinning" figures were sent out in the National Joint Council's circular dated 24th November 1995.
