Thank you for your emails of 6 and 11 July 2016.

I am entirely satisfied that the proposed Stage 2 hearing will comply with the Authority's own approved arrangements and statutory requirements.

I re-iterate that the Authority will not seek to recover any overpayment of pension benefits paid to you before October 2010. As you know, at that date, your pension benefits were recalculated to take account of the state benefits you were receiving. Accordingly, the Authority does not claim and has never sought to claim that any overpayments were made from October 2010 onwards. You do not, therefore, need to concern yourself any further in respect of claims for repayment of pension benefit by the Authority.

I believe that clarifies the position.

It would not be appropriate for me to provide you with advice regarding the Limitation Act 1980 or upon any other point of law. Should you require legal advice of any kind, you should consult your own solicitors.
