Application to His Honour Judge Butler.

Dear Mr. Harold,

I have this morning at 10:00hrs made Applications to HHJ Butler which I have requested that he deals with, in the first instance, at the commencement of Part 1 of the Trial on Tuesday 12th February 2013. I attach a copy for your information.

In the main, so that you may not be 'surprised' I seek that the Court makes an early Judgement on many points of law within applicable legislation to reduce further and future loss of valuable Court time.

By this Application I intend to draw to the Court's attention that you as my pension authority rather than compensating me as a victim of an industrial injury, as required by law, has enriched itself by illegally penalising me by using the facts of my injury to reduce my fully earnt, 33.5 years Ordinary service pension since 1997(15 years).

This must be the only occasion in English Legal History where damages for an injury have been measured by reducing an already earnt full able bodied Ordinary service pension!

I will suggest to the Court that for any trustees, particular one administering a local authority occupational pension scheme to act so is an unspeakable betrayal of trust deserving the utmost severity in censure by the Court.

This is reflected as you will have noted in my claim for £2.5million in exemplary damages.

Such a Judgement, if the Court so determines, will have nation-wide implications for the FRS; for Fire Service Veterans; for Police Veterans; and/or both their Widows and estates which have been in receipt of pensions since 1992.
