FIREFIGHTERS PENSION SCHEME
INJURY PENSION REVIEW

As you are aware Lancashire Fire & Rescue Service is currently reviewing injury pensions to ensure that the correct amount of injury pension is being paid to you (the review will not reassess the degree of your disablement).

As you know, you are required to inform me of any changes to the benefits being paid by the Department for Works and Pensions (DWP) or the Benefits Agency. However, you will recall that we wrote to you recently to ask you to complete a form providing us with authorisation to contact DWP so that we can confirm the amount of benefits in payment from them and ensure that your injury pension is correct.

Unfortunately DWP have returned your completed form and have asked us to reword the form in order to ensure that they are fully compliant with the Data Protection Act. I am therefore enclosing a slightly revised form for your completion. I apologise for any inconvenience but could you please return the form to me as soon as possible so that we can assess the level of benefits being paid to you. We will write to you again when this assessment has been completed.

Please be assured that we will carry out the assessment as soon as possible after we receive the information from DWP in order to avoid delaying this matter further.
